
ACCES AND DEPARTURE POINT

Acces: from the village take the road D89 and follow the direction "Le Drumont".

Departure: Car park at the Farm Inn Le Drumont (7, route du Drumont)









PARCOURS AND POINTS OF INTEREST

- → Pass the park chicane, on the left of the farmhouse inn, take the path that goes to the right and leads just above the farmhouse.
- ⇒Follow this path. Listen to the cowbells...
- ⇒Arrived at the crossing, take the path that goes up on the left and join the orientation table.

Look at this view!

You may be lucky enough to see paragliders take off...

From the orientation table, go down through the meadows on the opposite side. At the crossing, take the path left that will lead you to the farmhouse inn. You might see a donkey or pigs in the farm's stable.

The Farm Inn the Drumont is closed.





Thanks to the orientation table, this walk is an opportunity to discover or revise the cardinal points. You will also learn how to find your bearings with the sun; it rises in the East, sets in the West and is in the South at Noon.

What time is it?

Lie down in the grass, look at the clouds and their funny shapes, let your imagination run wild.

DID YOU KNOW THAT ...?

The marcaire meal word taken from the Alsatian dialect (Malker) which means "the one who milks the cows" - is the traditional menu served in the farm inns of the Hautes-Vosges. It consists of a soup or a tourte, smoked pork meat with Tofailles (sliced potatoes cooked for 2 or 3 hours in butter with onions and bacon). Munster cheese (or Bargkass) and a dessert (farmhouse fromage blanc sprinkled with kirsch or blueberry tart).

High place of resistance, the Chaume du Drumont was set on fire by the Germans on September 23, 1944. Hard fights were delivered by the Corps Franc Pommiés at the end of November 1944. A commemorating plaque remembers the sacrifice of those volunteers.

The Drumont is a typical summer pasture and is one of our "Must see" natural site. The elevation is low and the circular panorama view is amazing! The children can run around without limits, enjoy the animals and find the cardinal points on the orientation table.

Rando-Ferrata

For the taller than 1.40 M, the Rando-Ferrata is a trail that combines hiking and rock climbing along a fixed cable, facilitated by rungs, footbridges, etc...This activity requires specific equipment, you can rent it at the campsite at Bussang on reservation. 
