A beautiful walk on the Drumont ridge, with the Alps as a backdrop. Starting from the farm inn, you'll pass cows grazing on the mountain pastures and, if you look up, perhaps spot a few paragliders adding splashes of colour to the sky...

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ACCESS AND DEPARTURE POINT

Access : From the village of Bussang, take the D89 and follow signs for 'Le Drumont'.

Departure : Parking lot at Le Drumont farmhouse inn (7 route du Drumont).

ITINERARY AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Pass the park chicane, on the left of the farmhouse inn, take the path that goes to the right and leads just above the farmhouse.

Follow this path. Listen to the cowbells...

Arrived at the crossing, take the path that goes up on the left and join the orientation table. Look at this view!
You may be lucky enough to see paragliders take off...

From the orientation table, go down through the meadows on the opposite side. At the crossing, take the path left that will lead you to the farmhouse inn.

FOR THE CHILDREN

Thanks to the orientation table, this walk is an opportunity to discover or revise the points of the compass. You'll also learn how to find your bearings using the sun: it rises in the East, sets in the West and is in the South at midday. What time is it?

Lie down on the grass, observe the clouds and their funny shapes and let your imagination run wild.

DID YOU KNOW THAT ?

The marcaire meal

A word taken from the Alsatian dialect (malker) meaning 'he who milks the cows', this is the traditional menu served in the farm inns of the Hautes-Vosges. It consists of a soup or pie, smoked pork accompanied by tofailles (sliced potatoes cooked for 2 to 3 hours in farm butter with onions and bacon), munster (or bargkass) and a dessert (farm fromage blanc drizzled with kirsch or blueberry tart).

A major Resistance site, the Drumont thatch was burnt down by the Germans in 1944. The Corps Franc Pommiès fought hard there at the end of November 1944. A plaque commemorates their sacrifice.

Rando ferrata
